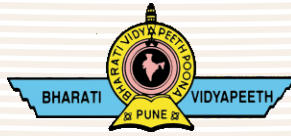
Bharati Vidyapeeth was established by Dr. Patangrao Kadam on 10th May 1964, when he was hardly nineteen years old. Dr. Kadam came from a middle level peasant family in a small village, Sonsal in Sangli district. Amidst great difficulty, Dr. Kadam completed his Primary and Secondary education in village schools and later enrolled himself for higher education in Rayat Shikshan Sanstha's College at Satara established by Karmveer Bhaurao Patil, who had done pioneering work in the field of education making it available to girls and boys even from distant villages. Inspired as he was by the work of Karmveer, Dr. Kadam made education, his life mission. Within a short span of time, Bharati Vidyapeeth became one of the largest educational organizations in the country with an excellent academic reputation. Dr. Kadam has been the chief Architect of the grand edifice of Bharati Vidyapeeth.

Dr. Kadam had a genuine concern for the upliftment of deprived and downtrodden, particularly village people, women and Dalits. So he made special effort to make education available to them, which he thought would help them to improve their prospects for better life.

All sided development of villagers had also been a major concern of Dr. Kadam. Realising that there is a huge potential in political power for improving the lot of common man, Dr. Kadam joined politics. He was elected as a Member of the Maharashtra Legislative Assembly six times over and also held the position of a Cabinet Minister for several years. He was entrusted with various ministerial portfolios including those of Education, Co-operation, Forest, Rehabilitation, Industry, and the like. As a Minister, Dr. Kadam initiated various innovative programmes that helped people to considerably improve the quality of their life.

Yet another field of Dr. Kadam's interest, was Co-operation. He did splendid work in the field of co-operation. He realised that Cooperation activities would increase the self-confidence of people and imbibe in their minds the spirit of self-development. So he successively established various cooperative units including Sugar Factories, a Bank, a Milk Society, Spinning Mills etc. invoking people's participation in them.

Dr. Kadam had multi-dimensional personality. He gave a very enlightened and visionary leadership to the people of Maharashtra. He was a great philanthropist and offered help to needy persons who sought his help. He had interests in varied activities including those in sports literature, arts, social work etc.

Bharati Vidyapeeth which is one of the largest educational organizations in the country was established by Dr. Patangrao Kadam on 10th May 1964. It started its activities with competitive examination in English and Mathematics for school going children with a view to generate interest for these subjects in their minds and improve their proficiency in them. Now, Bharati Vidyapeeth is having under its umbrella 80 colleges imparting education in the subjects covered by 12 faculties. Besides these Colleges, Bharati Vidyapeeth also runs 73 Schools including some junior colleges, imparting education at pre-primary, primary and secondary levels.

Bharati Vidyapeeth has its major campuses in Pune, Navi Mumbai, Kolhapur, Solapur, Karad, Sangli and New Delhi, the capital city of India. Among the 80 Colleges which Bharati Vidyapeeth runs are colleges of Medicine, Dentistry, Ayurved, Pharmacy, Environment, Law, Engineering, Architecture, Hotel Management, Biotechnology, Information and Communication Technologies, Geo-informatics and the like. While establishing Bharati Vidyapeeth, the Founder, Dr. Patangrao Kadam had mentioned in its constitution that subsequently Bharati Vidyapeeth would be developed into a full-fledged University. His dream came to be true when the Government of India on the recommendation of UGC conferred the status of "Deemed to be University" on a cluster of 12 colleges / institutes in April 1996. The number of constituent colleges of this University has now grown up to 29.

Within a short span of two decades or so, the University has established its academic credentials so much so that it is now being recognized as one of the leading Universities in the country. Its high academic stature has been underlined by the fact that the National Assessment and Accreditation Council has awarded 'A+' Grade in its 3rd round of Assessment to this University. It is also recognized as a 'A' Grade University by the Ministry of Human Resource Development, New Delhi.

The Founder of Bharati Vidyapeeth was very keen on offering various academic options to the students as well as on providing them education in a very proficient environment. His vision is reflected in the fact that all the campuses of Bharati Vidyapeeth including those of Schools are well-maintained and every institution has its own building. Bharati Vidyapeeth's institutions have well-developed libraries, laboratories, playgrounds, hostels etc. with advanced digitization. All the amenities which are necessary for good education are provided to the students of Bharati Vidyapeeth with a view to develop the potentials they have in such areas as Arts, Literature, Sports etc.

The track record of success of students of Bharati Vidyapeeth's schools in the 10th and 12th Board Examinations is indeed very enviable. The percentage of successful students in these examinations in almost all the Schools of Bharati Vidyapeeth is more than 95%.

THE CONSTITUTION OF INDIA

PREAMBLE

We, THE PEOPLE OF INDIA, having solemnly resolved to constitute India into a SOVEREIGN SOCIALIST SECULAR DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC and to secure to all its citizens

Justice, Social, Economic and Political;

Liberty Of Thought, Expression, Belief, Faith And Worship;

EQUALITY of status and of opportunity and to promote among them all;

FRATERNITY assuring the dignity of the individual and the unity and integrity of the Nation.

In OUR CONSTITUENT ASSEMBLY this twenty-sixth day of November, 1949, do
HEREBY ADOPT, ENACT AND GIVE TO OURSELVES THIS CONSTITUTION.

CHAPTER IV A - FUNDAMENTAL DUTIES

ARTICLE 51 A

Fundamental Duties -

It shall be the duty of every citizen of India :

- a) To abide by the Constitution and respect its ideals and institutions, the National Flag and the National Anthem;
- b) To cherish and follow the noble ideals which inspired our national struggle for freedom;
- c) To uphold and protect the sovereignty, unity and integrity of India;
- d) To defend the country and render national service when called upon to do so;
- e) To promote harmony and the spirit of common brotherhood amongst all the people of India transcending religious, linguistic and regional or sectional diversities; to renounce practices derogatory to the dignity of women;
- f) To value and preserve the rich heritage of our composite culture;
- g) To protect and improve the natural environment including forests, lakes, rivers, wild life and to have compassion for living creatures;
- h) To develop the scientific temper, humanism and the spirit of inquiry and reform;
- i) To safeguard public property and to abjure violence;
- j) To strive towards excellence in all spheres of individual and collective activity so that the nation constantly rises to higher levels of endeavour and achievement.
- k) To provide opportunities for education by the parents / guardian to his ward between the age 6-14 years as the case may be.

GENERAL RULES OF CONDUCT

- ★ Student must not tear any page from this calendar.
- ★ Student must strictly adhere to all the rules mentioned in this Almanac and those notified by the school from time to time.

1. ATTENDANCE & LEAVES

- a) Students must be regular in his/her class and with minimum 80% attendance.
- b) Student should not remain absent for any reason other than sickness, without obtaining prior permission of the Principal.
- c) Absence due to sickness will have to be condoned only if there is a written application from the parent/guardian along with a medical certificate from a competent medical practitioner as early as possible. A student having a contagious or infectious disease will not be allowed to attend the School unless a proper Medical certificate is submitted.
- d) Application for leave due to some other reasons or seeking permission to take the student out during the school hours must be submitted through the relevant pages provided in this Almanac.

2. OTHER RULES

- a) Students must come to school on time. Attendance in the morning assembly is compulsory.
- b) Late comers, without a note signed by the Parent/ Guardian mentioning a genuine reason will be dealt strictly. **Student will be excused only thrice per term in an academic year, after which he / she shall be sent home.**
- c) No student will be allowed to leave the school premises during the school hours.
- d) The students are advised not to bring any valuable articles to the school. The authorities do not stand responsible for the loss of the student's books, money and other articles.
- e) The students are expected to handle the school property carefully. Any damage to any school property will be recovered from the responsible ones.

- f) To acquire greater fluency in English language, the students are advised to converse in English in class room and within the school premises.
- g) Any student who is persistently insubordinate or repeatedly guilty of malpractice/serious indiscipline is liable for punishment / may be expelled from the school.
- h) A student is not allowed to enter any classroom other than his/her own.
- i) A student must keep up the prestige and tradition of the school.
A student must not take part in any political activity.
- j) Students should not run inside the school, except playground .

3. A WORD TO THE PARENT.

- a) Parents are requested to co-operate with the school authorities by enforcing regularity, punctuality and discipline for all round development of their ward.
- b) Parents should encourage their ward.
 - To take active part in school activities.
 - To attend the school on time
 - To come in full uniform and with school material
 - To appear for tests as per given schedule.
 - To follow the instruction given by the teachers and other staff members.
- c) If the parents find any difficulty regarding the studies of the ward they can bring it to the notice of the school Principal/ Vice Principal without any hesitation.
- d) Any parent who wants to see his/her ward in the school or to fetch them before time must ask for the written permission of the Principal.

Your entry in the school is restricted till office. Please do not go in classes except on open days.

- e) The parents/ guardians should address all correspondence in respect of their wards to the Principal only, in the proforma given at the end of the calendar.
- f) Teachers are not allowed to conduct private tuitions of the same school students where they are serving.

Further they are allowed to conduct tuitions only after obtaining written permission from the Principal. A record of tuitions given by the teachers is maintained by the school.

- g) Parents with late tiffin are expected to drop it at "Tiffin Point" with proper labelling consisting (Std., Div. and name of the ward.) Students are expected to pick it up on his own. (except pre-primary)
- h) Criticism of the school policy or about any teacher's deeds should be avoided in the presence of students.
- i) Do not send sick or unwell child to the school even during exams .

4. SAFETY

- a) Parents / students will use entry-exit gate as per instructions.
- b) Visitors are granted entry till office only against identification verified by the security & wearing visiting card.
- c) Peons & teachers on floor are responsible for the smooth flow of students and prohibit entry of any other person.
- d) School premise is well protected by compound walls, gates, watchmen & CCTV surveillance.
- e) Pre-primary & Std. I-II kids are handed over to Parents in the supervision of peon / teacher
- f) Premise is well equipped with advance safety systems e.g. fire extinguishers on every floor, R.O. water facilities & floor observers.
- g) Students are not allowed to use motorized two wheelers without license and helmet .

5. LIBRARY

- a) The Students from std. III onwards will get Library books once in a week.
- b) All students are expected to keep the record of the Library books read by them every week in the proforma provided in this Almanac
- c) The students must use the book very carefully . He must not tear any page. The students have to repay / refund if the book is damaged by him/her.
- d) Students are strictly warned not to write anything on the Library books.
- e) Students must make a library card / pass for using library books.

6. ADMISSION RULES:

- a) Admission can be pursued only when parents submit prescribed online application form available at the school's official website bvemsdhan.bharatvidyapeeth.edu / Hard copy available in school office.
- b) The parent or an authorized guardian will have to accompany the ward while seeking admission.

- c) For fresh admission in nursery or admission of 1st std, Parents have to submit original Birth certificate issued by Municipal Corporation or Health Department.
- d) Boys and girls who have completed the age of 6 on or before 30th September of the pertaining year can only be admitted to the First standard
- e) A student coming from a recognized school, can be admitted only after producing original Leaving Certificate from the school and countersigned by the Educational authority of the state concerned if the student is transferring from other state.
- f) Admission will be confirmed only after -
 - Submission of original Birth certificate / T.C./ L.C.
 - Along with full fee payment for that academic year.

7. WITHDRAWAL

- a) Fill standard format of L.C demand which is available in school office. It should be submitted by parent or authorized guardian only. Student cannot submit it on his own.
- b) L.C/T.C will be issued within 8 days after submitting written application by parent.
- c) Applications received before / on result day & before Commencement of the new academic year will be processed without any Academic fees.
